### **Nepal Earthquake**

AFNA & the Assamese community in USA raised to the hour of need when the devastating earthquake hit Nepal in April this year. We raised more than a thousand dollars from the Assamese community and with funds from our General Fund, AFNA donated a total of \$1660 to the Nepal Relief Fund of Save the Children.

#### **AKADAMICS**

We lunched AKADAMICS only last year but the impact and the reach is overwhelming. We started with 8 scholarships last year and plan to add another 16 this year. **We have received 2200+ applications this year**. Our volunteers and the selection board spent weeks to go through them and shortlist 130 candidates for further screening.

#### Work An Hour

Every year during Rongali Bihu, we ask our wellwishers to donate an hour's worth of their wage to AFNA. While we celebrate the Assamese new year, its also a gesture to help the needy back in Assam.

## **RVC** Health education/intervention project

The new initiative on health education with RVC aims to reduce the high Maternal Mortality Rate in 10 villegeses in Dhemaji Dist of Assam. These villeges are hit by flood every year. With our funding, RVC has started promoting Youth & Mothers groups and have held the 1st workshop for the Youth in the impacted villeges. 12 students from Tata Institute of Social Science have joined this project as interns and helping on it.
